The School gives participants the chance to learn about contemporary issues in economic theory and practice, to interact and share their views and experiences with eminent professors and young intellectuals.

### THE SCHOOL OFFERS:

**18 hours of lectures and 8 hours of interactive workshops and discussions.** The School's goal is twofold:

- **To provide education on contemporary economic issues which are usually not covered by the university curriculum**
- **To establish durable links between young professionals and likely future leaders in the SEE region**

The School applies interactive methods of education by combining lectures and debates. Emphasis is put on the active participation of students in the education process. Lecturers at the Summer School of Economics are distinguished international scholars, professors from the region and beyond and local economic policy makers, experts from various institutions including World Bank, OECD, IMF and other domestic and international organisations. Participation at the Summer School of Economics is completely **free of charge for all selected participants**.

### TARGET GROUP

The target group are **advanced undergraduate (at least 3rd year of bachelor studies) and graduate students in social sciences and humanities from the Western Balkan region**. The Organization Committee will select around 30 candidates (15 students from the Western Balkan region or the EU and 15 from Serbia), with outstanding applications who demonstrate an interest in the main topics of the school and eagerness to learn and interact.
