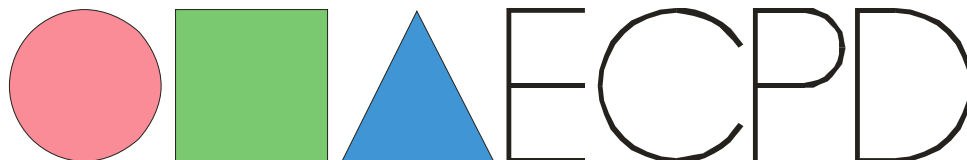

We have the pleasure to invite you to take part in the work of **Twenty first ECPD International Summer School of Management of Health Care Institutions** (hereinafter: School), devoted to a highly topical issue: **Health Systems in Economic and Migrant Crisis**. This year's ECPD International Summer School continues with current topics in the field of health management and extends the tradition of gathering health managers and other decision makers in health care systems from the region of South-east and Central Europe.
