

AGREEMENT ON ACADEMIC CO-OPERATION
BETWEEN
TECHNICAL INSTITUTE OF PHYSICS AND CHEMISTRY,
CHINESE ACADEMY OF SCIENCES, BEIJING, CHINA
AND
UNIVERSITY OF KRAGUJEVAC, REPUBLIC OF SERBIA

Technical Institute of Physics and Chemistry, Chinese Academy of Sciences and the University of Kragujevac, agree to sign this Agreement on Co-operation which will regulate the terms and conditions of the co-operation in the field of teaching, scientific and research work, publishing activities and exchange of students.

I LECTURES AND COURSES

The contracting Institutions agree to:

1. Share experience related to the organization, performance and improvement of the lecturing process;
2. Exchange lecturing plans and programs and other curricular literature;
3. Exchange faculty staff to lecture or give courses on subjects of mutual interest.

II SCIENTIFIC AND RESEARCH WORK

The contracting Institutions agree to:

1. Encourage the organization and realization of work on mutual scientific and research projects;
2. Engage scientific and research workers from the partner institution to participate in home research projects;
3. Exchange scientific papers and annals and jointly publish them in publications issued by the institutions;
4. Jointly compete for internationally financed scientific and research projects;
5. Exchange information and jointly take part in scientific conferences to mutual benefit.

III PUBLISHING ACTIVITIES

In order to enhance publishing activities, the contracting institutions agree to:

1. Jointly publish lecturing material whose authors are the professors and associates of the contracting institutions;
2. Enable their professors and associates to publish their articles and papers in the partner institution publications;
3. Jointly publish collected works from mutually organized conferences or from the conferences on which they jointly participated.

IV EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS

The contracting institutions agree to:

1. Encourage the exchange of students from the contracting institutions;
2. Encourage students from the contracting institutions to jointly compete and participate in internationally financed programs;
3. Encourage the participation of students from the contracting institutions in students' conferences;
4. Support the co-operation of students from the contracting institutions in cultural and sport activities.

V ORGANIZATION OF CO-OPERATION

The contracting institutions agree to:

1. The implementation of any of the types of cooperation shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support at the institutions concerned;
2. In order to further develop their co-operation, the contracting institutions agree to modify and amend this Agreement upon mutual consent;
3. The contracting institutions agree to transfer their rights and obligations from this Agreement to other institutions from their respective countries upon mutual consent;
4. In case that one contracting institution has some doubts related to this Agreement on Co-operation, it should notify the partner institution. All problems should be solved in mutual discussion. In the case the problems still persist, they are to be solved on a relevant state institutional level;
5. This Agreement is signed for a five-year period and starts operating with the date of its signing by representatives of contracting institutions;
