

COOPERATION AGREEMENT

Between,

1. University of Kragujevac, Faculty of Education, Milana Mijalkovića 14, Jagodina, Republic of Serbia, represented by Dean Prof. Dr. Violeta Jovanović (hereinafter referred to as: Faculty of Education) and

2. NIS schools, El-Tagammoe El-Awwal, Extension of Zaker Hussein st, First Settlement, Cairo, Republic of Egypt, founded and owned by Dr. Nermien Ismail, (hereinafter referred to as: NIS schools).

The common term for all participants in the agreement is "contracting parties." With the aim of strengthening international cooperation in the fields of education, culture, and research, the contracting parties have agreed as follows in this Agreement:

Article 1.

The cooperation includes: connecting the Faculty of Education with all schools within the NIS schools educational system in Egypt, participation in joint activities of students, pupils, and teachers, and the development of projects in the fields of culture and education.

Article 2.

The institutions will work together to develop and improve practice in the field of upbringing, education and culture. In order to design, plan and implement joint activities, the institutions will hire experts from both sides to participate in the work.

Article 3.

The institutions will collaborate in the field of education and professional development of the teaching staff of the NIS schools system, within the accredited programs of the Faculty of Pedagogical Sciences, University of Kragujevac, Jagodina. The contracting parties commit to providing adequate conditions for the implementation of the agreed activities in the realization of these programs.

Article 4.

The contracting parties agree to establish cooperation in the following segments of work:

- research activities in the implementation of international and national projects,
- conducting practical training for students of the Faculty of Education in NIS schools,
- participation in the implementation of activities in the field of culture and education,
- organization and participation in conferences, seminars, and workshops,
- professional development and lifelong education of the teaching staff of NIS schools,
- other activities of common interest.

Article 5.

Specific individual obligations in the implementation of particular activities may be regulated by the contracting parties through the conclusion of a separate agreement.

Article 6.

Any disputes arising from the implementation of this Agreement will be resolved by the contracting parties through mutual agreement. If an agreement cannot be reached, the dispute will be brought before the competent court at the place of the defendant's registered office.

Article 7.

The Agreement shall take effect from the date of signing and is valid for a period of four (4) years. The content of the agreement may be modified if both parties agree. All modifications and amendments must be in written form.

Article 8.

The Agreement is drawn up in four (4) identical copies, of which each contracting party shall receive two (2) copies.
