Concluded on 8.07.2024 between:

**1. FACULTY OF TECHNOLOGY AND METALLURGY Saints Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje**, located at add. "Ruđer Bošković", no. 16, represented by Dr. Stefan Kuvendziev, associate professor, Legal Representative, and Dean (hereinafter: the first contracting party), and

**2. FACULTY OF TECHNICAL SCIENCES ČAČAK University in Kragujevac**, located at add. „Svetog Save“, no. 65, represented by Dr. Danijela Milošević, full professor, Legal Representative and Dean (hereinafter: the second contracting party)

**Article 1**

This Memorandum of Cooperation establishes the framework between the two contracting parties for matters of common interest based on the use of the scientific-professional, professional, material-technical, and spatial conditions aimed at the advancement of educational, research, and application activities, through which the cooperation between both contracting parties, for matters of common interest.

**Article 2**

The contracting parties agree that the cooperation will be realized through the following activities:

- joint work on diploma, master's, and doctoral theses;
- organization and active activities of application projects and mutual exchange of information;
- professional, scientific, and technical support in the preparation of technical analyses according to the needs of the contracting parties;
- consultative activities;
- formation of expert teams for the development of scientific research and application projects;
- involvement of both contracting parties in project activities of mutual interest;
- using a faculty center to achieve common goals
- other areas of common interest on which cooperation is based.

**Article 3**

This memorandum is concluded for 3 (3) years from the date of signing.

The validity of the memorandum is automatically extended for the next 3 (three) years, except if one of the parties does not provide the other party with an official written notice of termination of the memorandum 30 days in advance.

**Article 4**

The memorandum is considered valid when the authorized signatories of both contracting parties sign it.

**Article 5**

The memorandum can be amended or supplemented, and each amendment and addition must be made in writing and signed by authorized persons of both contracting parties.

### Article 6

Any form of cooperation envisaged by the Memorandum, upon the request of one of the contracting parties, will be regulated by a separate agreement that will regulate the rights and obligations of both contracting parties.

### Article 7

When performing their obligations and activities, the contracting parties are obliged to work conscientiously and responsibly, applying their knowledge and work experience, and by established business ethics, which will contribute to the successful realization of the cooperation.

### Article 8

Any disputes from mutual relations from the cooperation that would arise with the application of this Memorandum, the contracting parties will primarily resolve amicably.

### Article 9

This Memorandum is compiled in 4 (four) copies and each of the contracting parties keeps 2 (two) copies.


