It displays exclusive rarities: the music of the monasteries of the Hellenistic and Balkan regions, the so-called monodies from Russia and the Ukraine as well as the Greek Catholic tradition of the Carpathian Basin.

You can listen to the unique and enchanting singing of the Saint Ephraim Male Choir.

You will be able to listen to excellent artists renown both in Hungary and worldwide such as: Márta Sebestyén, Tünde Szabóki, Anatolij Fokanov – this time in the set provided by Byzantine music.

You may get to know star performers from the east not known in Hungary: Nektaria Karantzi (Athens), Dragoslav Pavle Aksentiyevich (Belgrade), The Barilli Women's Choir with Katalin Tasic (Pozharyevats).

You may get to know the rather special musical world of the Hungarian Greek Catholic liturgy with the expertly guidance of the inspired song of Fülöp Kocsis, bishop of Hajdúdorog Bishopric.

On the scene of the concerts the compilation CD Orientale Lumen 2011/12 will be available.

All the above you will be able to experience in the fascinating setting provided by the magnificent interior of Budapest's Saint Stephen Basilica.
